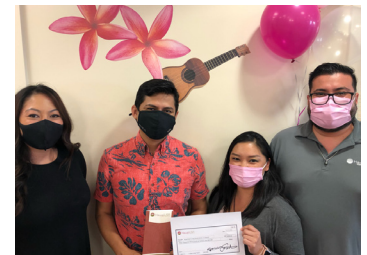
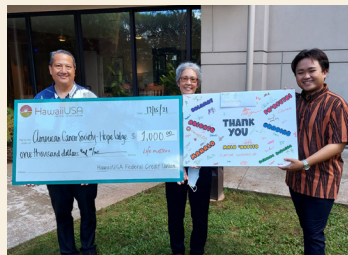
FOUNDATION DONATION
